- 4) At this season of your life, what do you think God's top priorities are for you?
- 5) How can you start or continue to build your calendar around things that are important to God?
- 6) Are you burying any of the resources God has entrusted to you? If so, how can you use those resources to invest in things that matter to God?
- 7) What good things are you doing currently that are robbing you of time spent on the best things?
